## **Bioanalytical Scientist**

As a scientist within Bioanalysis and Services at Mercodia, you will work with planning, performing, and reporting analyses with methods to measure larger molecules under regulatory requirements. You handle sample receipt and accessioning, plan for analysis, data compilations and reports in LIMS, Excel, and Word. You will maintain and manage the lab including equipment and systems.

This position is located in our new laboratory in Winston-Salem, NC. As a Bioanalytical Scientist, you are a member of the Bioanalytical and Services team and reports to Director Bioanalytical and Services.

### **Job description**

The work will be carried out as projects, and you will be responsible for reporting your work to a project manager. Your duties include, but are not limited to, control and calibration of instruments and equipment, maintenance of lab, SOPs and ordering and inventorying of laboratory supplies. You may be involved validating/setting up new methods and/or platforms in the lab.

### **Skills, Competence and Experience**

Prerequisites for this position is a minimum of a (4) year undergraduate degree, preferably in the natural and/or human sciences. Ability to use LIMS and Microsoft Office is required; previous experience in these programs is highly desired. You need to be organized and able to prioritize between different tasks.

It is preferred if you have 1-2 years of experience in related work environment, experience with immunoassays / ELISA and experience working in a regulated environment, such as GLP/GCP. You should have the ability to manage more than one project in parallel.
